### Practice

I specialise in personal injury cases, including Clinical Negligence. I have a special interest in Fatal Accident Act cases. My practice is almost exclusively on behalf of Claimants with injuries and losses which are likely to merit an award of in excess of £50,000. I regularly conduct cases worth in excess of £250,000. I am presently involved in a number of cases which are worth potentially worth in excess of £1m. In the area of fatal accidents, I have dealt with many truly tragic cases including cases in which both parents in a family have been killed; a parent (in a single parent family) has been killed, completely orphaning the dependants; cases where one parent has been killed, so traumatising the other parent that they developed serious psychiatric problems. As well as the problems raised by the self employed and those with wildly fluctuating employment histories.

I have experience in personal injury cases dealing with serious brain and spine damage, chronic pain, somatoform pain disorder, stress at work, repetitive strain injury and industrial deafness, obstetrics and gynaecology, renal problems, colon problems, cardiac problems and amputations.

I was Junior Counsel in the case of *Stringman v. McCardle* in which the Court of Appeal decided that the Defendant had no legitimate interest in how a Claimant proposed to spend an interim payment.
