### Professional Negligence CV

#### Overview

For eight years, Jonathan was head of the Commercial Insurance Litigation department at the leading insurance firm, Keoghs. ## Cases

### Examples of cases in which Jonathan has been and is involved:

- Successful claim against solicitors and a successor practice arising from a failed foreign property transaction
- Successful claim against solicitors arising from a fraudulent property transaction, issues involving whether or not a duty owed by a solicitor to the third-party claimant could be established
- Advising in relation to a professional negligence claim against Lloyds brokers following a refusal by the Lloyds syndicate to indemnify under an insurance policy following a building fire.
- Representing an architect in TCC proceedings in a very significant claim for professional negligence involving renovation of a listed building
- Representing a former client of solicitors who was made bankrupt as a result of breaches of duty in advice and representation
- Advising in relation to a claim against insurance brokers arising from a failure to arrange adequate cover in relation to a caravan park which suffered catastrophic damage following a landslip. A successful settlement was negotiated.
- Advising structural steel designer/manufacturer in a claim against insurance brokers for breach of duty to advise and arrange adequate cover as a result of a refusal of indemnity following catastrophic failure during the building of a flagship car showroom.
