Overview

Professor David Milman is a Professor of Law at Lancaster University, which he joined in 2005, and where he held the post of Head of Department at the Law School between 2008 and 2011. Previously, he had been at the University of Manchester where he was Dean of Law between 1995 and 1997.

He is Consultant Editor of the Annotated Guide to the Insolvency Legislation, Insolvency Intelligence and the Bankruptcy and Personal Insolvency Reports and has numerous other publications. He is an honorary member of the Insolvency Lawyers' Association and is a subscriber member of R3.

His research interests lie in the fields of company law, insolvency law, international business law and partnership law. He has carried out funded research for the DTI, the Chartered Association of Certified Accountants, the Insolvency Lawyers' Association, the Centre for Business Performance at the ICAEW and insolvency practitioners.

His current research focus is in the area of bankruptcy law and personal credit and he is also working on corporate law reform and the problems of convergence in national systems of Company Law.

In 2010, Professor David Milman formalised his relationship with Exchange Chambers by joining us as a Professorial Associate.
