## Cases

R v SP Sheffield Crown Court 2022. Operation Jaguar. 9 handed defence trial violent disorder, representing 1 defendant. Secured unanimous acquittal of the Defendant.

R v SD 2022 Leeds Magistrates Court. Successful acquittal of D charged with section 47 ABH and criminal damage.

R v IQ York Crown Court 2023. Secured suspended sentence on a guilty plea to a section 18 offence.

R v GS 2023 Leeds Crown Court. Secured a 2 month suspended sentence on a guilty plea to pervert the course of justice.

R v MM 2023 prosecuted handling stolen goods recovered worth in excess of £100,000

R v HK 2023 led by senior counsel on a 2 week baby shaking trial. Secured unanimous acquittal of the Defendant.
